

YOU HAVE RIGHTS!

**IF YOU HAVE BEEN DETAINED CALL
1-866-439-6631 to speak with an advocate that will
provide you with legal information.**

**Do not sign any document until you have spoken with
an attorney!** This document might allow them to deport
you.

You have the right to make a phone call.

You have the right to speak to a lawyer.

You have the right to remain silent unless your lawyer is
present.

You have the right to a hearing before an immigration
judge.

IF YOUR FAMILY MEMBER HAS BEEN DETAINED:

If government officials come to your door, DO NOT open
the door unless they have a warrant.

If government officials enter your home without a warrant,
tell them you do not consent to the search.

You have the right to remain silent if someone asks about
your status.

You have the right to speak to a lawyer, and to remain silent
until your lawyer is present.

You do not have to show anyone your papers if they ask.

If you are undocumented, DO NOT attempt to visit your
family member in detention.
